FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply for M. Sc. (Physics) entrance examination?

- B.Sc. (Physics), B.Sc. (Chemistry), B.Sc. (Mathematics), B.Sc (Electronics Science) or B.E. (any branch) passed or appeared students can apply for entrance examination.

2. Is M. Sc. (Physics) part time or full time course?

- This is full time course.
Lectures/Practical (Lab. work) timing is from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm.

3. Can final year B.Sc. / B.E. students apply for the test?

- Yes.
Final year B.Sc. / B.E. students can apply for the test. If they clear the test, their admission will be subject to the final year results.

4. What is the syllabus for the entrance examination?

- Graduation Level Physics Syllabus.

6. What is the date and time of Entrance Examination?

- Entrance examination is scheduled to be held on Sunday, 8th June, 2014. Duration of examination is 3 hours i.e. 2.00 pm. to 5.00 pm. at different centers.

7. Which are the examination centers?

- Pune, Mumbai, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Nagpur, Sangali, Dhule, New Delhi, Kolkata and Bangalore.

8. Is it possible to change examination center once assigned?

- No.

9. What will be the nature of the questions?

- Objective type multiple choice questions -choose one correct answer out of the 4 options.

10. How many questions will be in the question paper?

- 50 questions. All questions are compulsory.

11. Is there any negative marking system?

- Yes.

12. What is the marking system?

- If student attempts “A” no. of questions and if “C” no. of questions solved are correct, then the score is
$$= (4 C - A).$$

13. What is the last date of submission of online application form?

- 20th May, 2014.

14. Can I apply after 20th May 2014?

➤ No.

15. What documents should be attached with application form?

➤ Proof of payment receipt and photograph.

16. What is the last date of submission of application form with requisite payment proof to the Head, Department of Physics, University of Pune, Pune - 411007?

➤ 20th May, 2014. 6.00 pm.

17. What is the address of Examination Centre?

➤ The address of examination centre will be printed on Hall Ticket.

18. When I can get the hall ticket?

➤ You can print the Hall Ticket on June 1st, 2014 onwards.

19. Should I eligible to take admission in any affiliated college of University of Pune after giving entrance examination conducted by Department of Physics, University of Pune?

➤ No.

This entrance examination is specifically for M.Sc. (Physics) of Department of Physics, University of Pune only and not for the affiliated colleges.

20. What is percentage of reservation for backward class students?

- 50 % reservation will be followed at every stage as per Govt. of Maharashtra resolution which will be applicable to only the students having domicile of state of Maharashtra and caste certificate issued by competent authority.

21. Is reserved category is applicable for the students of all states in India?

- No.
Reservation is applicable for Maharashtra domicile SC, ST, DT/NT, OBC, SBC category as per the reservation policies of Government of Maharashtra. Non-creamy layer certificate is necessary for OBC, NT(A), NT (B), NT(C), NT (D) and SBC category students.

22. Is there any reservation for physically challenged students?

- Yes,
3% seats are reserved for physically challenged students. This reservation is applicable to students of Indian nationality.

23. Is there any reservation for child of defence personal/ Ex-Serviceman child?

- Yes.
5% seats are reserved for defence personal/ Ex-serviceman child. This reservation is applicable to students of Indian nationality.

24. Is there any reservation for Kashmir migrate students?

- Yes.
One seat will be reserved for Kashmir migrate students over and above the intake capacity based on the entrance test score.

25. Is there any difference in the merit list of University of Pune students and other university students?

- Yes, for Pune University students doing their B.Sc. (Physics) carry 50% weightage to the entrance examination score and 50 % weightage for principal subject (Physics) total of B.Sc out of 1200.

For all other students, 100% weightage is given to the Entrance examination score only.

26. Does M. Sc. student get stipend?

- No, however, a few scholarships, each with limited amount, may be available on the yearly basis and through a selection process, to the deserving students.

27. May I know the total intake capacity of the Department of Physics, University of Pune?

- Total **90** students.

28. What is the intake capacity of Pune University students?

- 70 % of the total intake capacity.

29. Who is the student of University of Pune?

- The student passed 10th and 12th slandered exam. from state of Maharashtra and B. Sc. from University of Pune

OR

Domicile of state of Maharashtra and B. Sc. from university of Pune.

30. What is the procedure for M.Sc. (Physics) admission for international (Foreign) students?
