ADMISSION: M.Sc. PHYSICS FOR THE YEAR 2012-13

The Department of Physics offer a 2 years (Four Semesters) M.Sc. Physics degree programme comprising of 15 common basic courses, 3 elective course's including one Laboratory course and a project equivalent to 2 courses. The following elective courses are offered in the second year of M.Sc. (Physics)- Materials Science, Physics of Thin Films, Condensed Matter, Microwaves: Theory and Application, Biophysics, Nuclear Techniques, Accelerators Physics, Laser Physics, Non-linear Dynamics, Astronomy and Astrophysics, Chemical Physics and Physics of Nanostructure & Nano-materials, etc.

ELIGIBILITY:

B.Sc. degree in any of the following subjects or combination : Physics, Electronics Science, Chemistry and Mathematics. In addition candidates with engineering degree B.E./B. Tech. are also eligible. Those appearing for the final year of B.Sc. / B.E./ B. Tech. degree examination to be conducted before June 2012 may also apply.

ADMISSION :

All the admissions are made through the ENTRANCE TEST. However, for the Pune University Physics students, admission is made on the basis of 50% weightage of the B.Sc. degree marks and 50% weightage of the score in the entrance test. For other University students 100% weightage is given to the Entrance Test score. Admissions are governed as per the Pune University Ordinance (163)

DETAILS OF THE ENTRANCE TEST :

The Entrance Test is objective type is likely to be conducted at the following cities: Pune, Mumbai, Nagpur, Nashik, Kolhapur, Solapur, Ahmednagar, New Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai and Bangalore (Depending on the number of candidates appearing for exam). Nearest centre will be allotted to the candidate if the centre proposed by him/her is cancelled. No T.A, D.A will be paid towards appearing for the Entrance Test or for any other purpose in this matter. The application form is available on University of Pune/Physics Department web site. Duly filled Entrance Test application form with the D.D. and a self addressed envelope (25cmX12cm) be sent 'To the Head, Department of Physics, University of Pune, Pune – 411 007' so as to reach on or before 23rd May 2012.

FEES DETAILS :

The D.D, of Rs. 500/- applicable for open category students and all categories students from outside Maharashtra State and Rs. 350/- for Reserved Category of only Maharashtra State. The D.D. should be drawn in favour of **"Registrar, University of Pune"**. The admission will be confirmed only after submitting the original mark sheet, leaving certificate and all necessary documents from the student

RESERVATION QUOTA:

50% seats are reserved for SC,ST,DT, NT & OBC, 3% Seats are reserved for physically handicapped persons as per Govt. of Maharashtra rules

SCHOLARSHIP:

A few scholarships, each with limited amount, are available on the yearly basis and through selection process awarded to the deserving students.
