

Department of Physics ADMISSION – M.Sc. PHYSICS-2006

The Department of Physics offers a 2 year M.Sc. Physics degree programme with the elective courses — Materials Science, Physics of Thin Films, Condensed Matter Theory, Microwaves, Biophysics, Nuclear Techniques, Accelerator Physics, Laser Physics, Non-Linear Dynamics, Astrophysics, Chemical Physics, and Nanotechnology. The course comprises of 16 compulsory Basic Physics courses, project worth two courses and two elective courses.

A FEW FELLOWSHIPS to the deserving students are available.

ELIGIBILITY: B.Sc. with Physics, Electronic Science, Chemistry, & Mathematics/B.E./B.Tech. Those appearing for final year of B.Sc./B.E./B.Tech. may also apply.

ADMISSION: All admissions are ONLY through the ENTRANCE TEST. For Pune University Physics students 50% weightage to their marks in B.Sc. and 50% to their score in the test. For others, 100% weightage to their test score, subject to a minimum of 50% aggregate for Bachelor degree.

DETAILS OF ENTRANCE TEST: Probable centers - Ahmednagar, New Delhi, Kolkata, Bangalore, Sangli, Mumbai, Nagpur, Nasik, & Pune. Nearest center will be allotted if the proposed center is cancelled. No T.A., D.A. will be given in order to appear for the entrance test.

Date and Time of the Test: Sunday 4th June 2006, 2-5 p.m.
